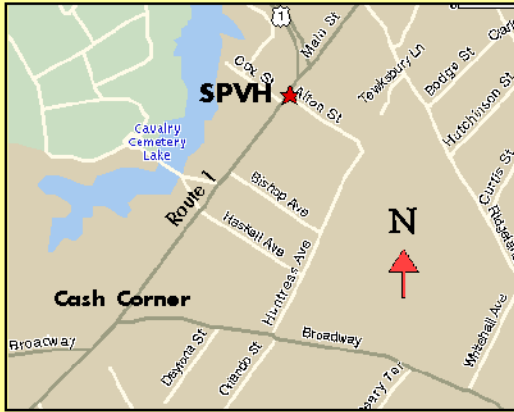


Where we are...

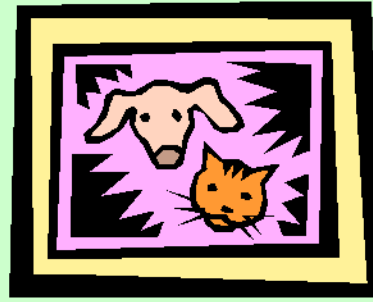

Who we are...

South Portland Veterinary Hospital opened its doors in September of 2003. Drs. Christopher and Jennifer Allen are a husband and wife team who have been practicing veterinary medicine since 1997. They met while attending the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine in Philadelphia, PA. The Allens moved to Maine in January, 2003, with their young son, two dogs and four cats. Dr. Jennifer Allen works full-time in South Portland while Dr. Christopher Allen splits his time between South Portland and the Eastern Maine Emergency Veterinary Clinic in Brewer.

Our all-new facility was converted in 2003 from a private residence. It is very bright and sunny throughout and includes a waiting room, two exam rooms, a large treatment area, an x-ray room, a pharmacy, a fully equipped surgery suite, and separate cat and dog wards for those animals who are staying with us.



As an added comfort, the cat ward is located in a quiet corner of the building and has many windows to help entertain and relax any kitties who need to stay in the hospital. Our dog ward is attached to a fenced area in the back, and we walk our canine patients frequently to help ensure their comfort.

What we do...

South Portland Veterinary Hospital was founded on the principles of providing quality health care in a loving and family environment. We are a fully equipped facility that provides services ranging from routine well-care to not-so-routine x-rays, surgery, and expert advice and care of sick animals. We pride ourselves on giving you the time you need to answer your questions and to talk about your concerns.

When surgery is necessary, we make every attempt to release your pet from the hospital the same day. All of our anesthetic protocols are designed with absolute safety and smooth, quick recoveries in mind. We place IV catheters and monitor all of our anesthetized patients very closely. Pain medication is not "optional" in our facility--we improve our protocols constantly and strive to keep your pet as comfortable as possible when we must perform a painful procedure.

All patients--inpatient and outpatient--are treated as we would treat our own pets. We understand that they are an important part of your family and want you and your pets to feel comfortable and at ease. We do not believe in "hard sells" or "guilt trips". We give you our honest opinions and take the time to explain our suggestions and treatments so that you can make informed decisions about your pet's health care.
